Summary of Tour Daily Activities

DAY 1 TRANSATLANTIC FLIGHT TO TEL AVIV

Today we depart from the United States and fly to Tel Aviv, Israel. Meals will be served in flight.

DAY 2 ARRIVE IN ISRAEL

Arrive in Ben Gurion International Airport in Tel Aviv. After securing our luggage, we will check into our hotel in Tiberias and enjoy our dinner and a good night's sleep.

DAY 3 CAESAREA / MT. CARMEL / MEGIDDO / NAZARETH / CANA / TIBERIUS

Travel to Caesarea by the Sea on the Mediterranean coastline. It was here that Cornelius the Centurion and his household were saved and baptized (Acts 10), and it was also where Paul made his defense before Festus and King Agrippa prior to his final journey to Rome (Acts 25 & 26). See the top of Mt. Carmel, where Elijah prayed down the fire from Heaven and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). Visit Megiddo and the Valley of Armageddon (Revelation 16). Pass through Cana where Christ performed His first miracle (John 2) and Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus (Luke 2). Arrive at Tiberius for check in, dinner and a good night's sleep.

DAY 4 SEA OF GALILEE / CAPERNAUM / MT. OF BEATITUDES / TABGHA / BOAT RIDE / JORDAN RIVER

Today we travel around the Sea of Galilee. Enter the 2,000 year-old remains of Capernaum (Luke 4) and stand in what is left of the synagogue in which our Lord ministered. Visit the traditional site where Jesus preached His Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5 - 7). Spend time at Tabgha, believed to be the place where Jesus fed the 5,000 from the two fish and the five loaves. Next enjoy a special time of worship during our boat ride across the Sea of Galilee. Finish out the day by the Jordan River where we will have a special service.

Day 5 CAESAREA PHILIPPI / GOLAN HEIGHTS / CHORAZIN / BETHSAIDA / KURSI

Start our day at Caesarea Philippi, where Jesus traveled with His disciples and where Peter made his great confession to Jesus, "Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God" (Matt. 16:16). Travel on through the strategic tableland known as the Golan Heights to see the Road to Damascus. It was along this road that Paul has his conversion experience. Visit Bethsaida where Jesus chose five of his disciples (Matt. 4:18-21; John 1:39-51). Chorazin is one of three cities cursed by Jesus because He did mighty works there and they "repented not" (Matt. 11:21). On the far shore of the sea is Kursi where Jesus cast out evil spirits from a demon-possessed man and cast them into a group of swine which ran violently down a steep hill and drowned in the sea (Mark 5:1-13).

Day 6 BET SHEAN / HAROD / JORDAN VALLEY / QUMRAN / MASADA / DEAD SEA / JERUSALEM

This morning, we say good-bye to the Galilee and begin our journey south. Visit the tel of Beth Shean, where the bodies of King Saul and his sons hung from the city gates (1 Samuel 31). As we travel through the Jordan Valley, we will stop at Harod, also known as the Gideon's Spring. Here, God chose the 300 men who would face the Midianite Army. Drive along the Jordan Valley to Qumran, site of the Dead Sea Scroll discovery. Enjoy a visit to Masada, the spectacular mountaintop fortress built by Herod which is famous as being the last stronghold of the Jewish rebellion against the Romans. Ride the cable car to the top to explore the fortress. Peer down

DAY 10 CROSS ALLENBY BRIDGE / MT. NEBO / KING'S HIGHWAY / PETRA

Visit Mt. Nebo, location of Moses' last view of the promised land before he died. Travel the King's Highway to Petra for dinner and overnight.

DAY 11 PETRA / AMMAN

Most of the day will be spent sightseeing in Petra. Return on King's Highway to Amman, capital city of Jordan for dinner and overnight.

DAY 12 RE-CROSS ALLENBY BRIDGE / DINNER / AIRPORT TRANSFER

Re-cross Allenby Bridge over the Jordan River into Israel. Enjoy dinner and prepare for the return flight home.

DAY 13 ARRIVE IN USA

upon the remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp below. Stop at the shores of the Dead Sea, lowest spot on earth, where those who desire may use the opportunity to touch these mineral laden waters whose buoyancy and medicinal benefits are legendary. Finally, we travel up through the Judean wilderness to the capital city of Jerusalem where we will check into our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 7 BETHLEHEM / MODEL CITY - SHRINE OF THE BOOK MUSEUM / MT. ZION / UPPER ROOM / CAIAPHAS' HOUSE / YAD VASHEM

After breakfast we will visit Bethlehem (Luke 2), the birthplace of our Lord. We return to Jerusalem and visit the remarkable Model of Jerusalem as it was laid out during the Roman occupation. Viewing this model will help us understand what the city looked like during the time of Christ. Wander the halls of the Shrine of the Book Museum, home of some of the Dead Sea scrolls. Then it is on to Mount Zion and the Upper Room, scene of the Last Supper of Jesus and His disciples and site of the traditional tomb of King David. Next stop is at the house of Caiaphas, who was the High priest at the time of Jesus' trial and crucifixion. While in Jerusalem, visit the Yad Vashem Museum for a somber reminder of the horrors of the holocaust with the purpose of never allowing this portion of history to repeat itself. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 8 MT. OF OLIVES / ASCENSION SITE / GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE / EMMAUS / VALLEY OF ELAH / SAMUEL'S TOMB

Stand atop the Mount of Olives as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of this Biblical centerpiece of history and prophecy. See olive trees that date back to the time of Christ. Ascend to the top of the Mount of Olives, to the Site of the Ascension (Acts 1). Visit the Chapel of the Ascension where Jesus ascended into heaven, then walk Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane for a time of reflection and gratitude for the sacrifice our Lord did for us. Journey to the ruins of Emmaus where Jesus met two of His disciples after His resurrection. They did not recognize Him until He later broke bread with them in their home (Luke 24:13-35). Pick up a smooth stone from the river bed in the Valley of Elah, just like David as he prepared to slay Goliath (1 Samuel 17). On our way back to Jerusalem, visit Samuel's Tomb (1 Samuel 25) and then return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 9 OLD CITY / GARDEN TOMB / GORDON'S CALVARY / LATE NIGHT FLIGHT TO USA

Touch a part of Herod's temple as we pray at the Western Wall. Walk through the Old City, visiting the pool of Bethesda (Jn. 5), and viewing the shops and the unique way of life that these ancient customs and lifestyles have maintained. Proceed to Pilate's Judgment Hall in the Fortress of Antonia (Jn. 18), see the games of the soldiers still etched in its stone floor, sense the agony of Christ's crucifixion at Gordon's Calvary (Lk. 23) and experience the exhilaration and reality of the resurrection at the Garden Tomb. After our final dinner in Israel, prepare for our departure back to the USA.

NOTE: Those who are not going on to Jordan will check out of the hotel rooms this morning. Jordan extension passengers will keep their rooms for their journey to Jordan in the morning.
